New Life Development Pre-Qualification Requirements

Please read thoroughly before submitting an application

Incarceration:

If you are currently incarcerated and serving a sentence for a past crime, you meet the target population that our program was designed for. If you are graduating residential substance abuse treatment then you are welcome to apply. However, we do not accept individuals who have been convicted of Sex Offenses or Arson. All other offenses are welcome to apply.

Past Incarceration:

If you released from prison within the past 4 years and are having trouble finding stable housing, or you feel you need a more structured housing environment, and you do not have a Sex Offense or Arson on your criminal record, we will consider your application.

Open Cases:

If you are trying to bail out of jail and have not yet been convicted, you may still apply to the New Life Development Program, however please note, we have a limited number of spaces for individuals with open cases. We do accept people on Pretrial Enforcement Division (PED) as well as applicants from other private owned third-party monitoring agencies. However, if you are fighting a Sexual Offense, we will not be able to house you. If you have an open case, other requirements will need to be fulfilled before you can be accepted. We no longer accept people on 24hr house arrest because employment is a requirement for program compliance.

Therapeutic Courts:

If you are applying for or you are already part of a Therapeutic Court, you will need to have that particular Therapeutic Court refer you to our program. All correspondence will need to go through the Therapeutic Court staff and not the individual applicant.

Disabled Applicants:

New Life Development has the capacity to house applicants with disabilities. We have first floor, ramps, and bathrooms for those with physical disabilities. We are limited in our capacity to house applicants with severe mental disabilities. If an applicant has a mental disability but are high functioning and do not require assistance in basic tasks such as preparing their own meals, keeping a neat living environment, and are not disruptive to the other program participants, then we can consider their application.

Sobriety:

New Life Development requires a 100% sober lifestyle. Substance abuse, including alcohol and marijuana use is not permitted while part of the residential program and will result in the immediate discharge from the program.

Program Fee's: The first program fee's are required at the time of arrival, unless those fee's are being covered by another agency and are verified prior to arrival.

Program Length: The length of the residential program varies due to the specific needs of each individual. The minimum length of stay is 6 months and there is no maximum. If an individual does not intend on staying for the minimum of 6 months, then they should not apply. This program is not designed for transient populations.
